DAY 1: WELLINGTON TO NELSON

On your first morning, cruise across the Cook Strait through the Marlborough Sounds to Picton. A short drive to Nelson will see us on the outskirts of Abel Tasman National Park. Azure skies and wide open spaces, beaches and lakes, spectacular national parks and unique landforms define this stunning region, and during the afternoon we have time to explore.

DAY 2: FREE DAY NELSON

Today we discover Abel Tasman National Park and you would be far pushed to find a more beautiful coastal environment. The park presents you with an array of perfect miniature beaches alongside golden sands, set against a canvas of blue sky, native bush and crystal clear water. One of our favourite options is a half day kayak to ‘Split Apple’ rock, or feel free to find a secluded beach and go snorkelling.

DAY 3: NELSON TO GREYMOUTH

Punakaiki is located near the centre of the “coast road” on the way to Greymouth and this is where we spend the afternoon of day 3. The drive is spectacular. Alternatively, you can experience exclusive grade 5 rapids, so secluded that they are only accessible via helicopter.

DAY 4: GREYMOUTH TO FRANZ JOSEF

We take the short trip to Franz Josef. How does sky diving high over the West Coast's rainforests sound? Experience beautiful views of Mount Cook, Fox and Franz Josef Glaciers, the most spectacular parts of the Southern Alps.

DAY 5: FREE DAY FRANZ JOSEF

Day 5 gives you the opportunity to experience the most dramatic glacial environment available to the general public anywhere in the world! From high in New Zealand's Southern Alps, the Franz Josef Glacier descends deep into the lush rainforest of Westland's National Park. There is an option to hike on Franz Josef with professional and experienced guides for either a half or full day.

DAY 6: FRANZ JOSEF TO WANAKA

From Franz Josef we amble towards Wanaka, passing through the rainforests in the Westland World Heritage Park to cruise along the western reaches of the South Island. The highlight of the journey is being greeted by the shores of picturesque Lake Wanaka and Lake Hawea. Both lakes are framed by awe-inspiring mountain ranges. Our wakeboarding/water-skiing packages or a lake cruise are an ideal way to spend a summer's afternoon. Driving a monster truck known as “School Bully” (the world's largest school truck) over a course of cars is undoubtedly a great stress buster and a lot of fun!

DAY 7: WANAKA TO QUEENSTOWN

An incomparable alpine panorama surrounds our accommodation along Lake Wanaka. New Zealand's tenth National Park, Mount Aspiring, is a complete snow sports destination, and is also world-renowned for its hiking trails. For those of you that want to up the ante, we have a selection of discounted heli-skiing options designed to take your Haka experience to a whole new level!

DAY 8: FREE DAY QUEENSTOWN

Take your pick from heli-rafting, canyoning, river surfing, bungee jumping the Nevis Bluff, snowboarding / skiing 4 different ski fields, the Canyon Swing, climbing, cliff jumping and jet boating!

DAY 9: QUEENSTOWN TO LAKE TEKAPO

A ski resort in winter and aquatic playground in summer, Lake Tekapo sits at the edge of the glacial lake of the same name, completely surrounded by the impressive Southern Alps. It is a picture perfect alpine village in the heart of the South Island high country. A scenic flight over two world heritage sites is a discounted activity for Haka customers.

DAY 10: LAKE TEKAPO TO CHRISTCHURCH

A short drive out travelling over the Burkes Pass and through the towns of Fairlie and Geraldine takes us to Christchurch in the early afternoon. Today we spend a relatively relaxed afternoon discovering the South Island's largest city.

DAY 11: FREE DAY CHRISTCHURCH

Christchurch is located on the east peninsula of the South Island and has some world class water-based activities. One option is our "Ultimate Day's Rafting" where we explore the intricate grade 5 rapids on the Rangitata River. Christchurch is also home to two ideal surfing beaches, Taylor's Mistake and Sumner Beach, and extreme jet boating on the Waimakairi River is sure to get the heart pounding!
