11 day south island Guided Tour



We will collect you from Christchurch Airport on your arrival the day prior to your tour, and take you to your hotel in Christchurch City. Meet your tour companions and be welcomed by your guides. After breakfast, we introduce you to your motorcycle and complete your paperwork, then we're off!

Saddle time is pure riding time – we stop for photos, drinks, lunches etc, so the actual travelling time is longer than the saddle time.

Day One - Christchurch to Hanmer Springs 150km In Saddle 2.5 hours

We leave Christchurch and head north along the coast road to the thermal resort of Hanmer Springs. We stay at Hanmer Springs, an idyllic little town set in a basin of forest-clad mountains and home of natural hot springs where we can soak and relax our aches away.



Day Two - Hanmer Springs to Punakaiki 253Km 3.5 hrs in saddle

Today we ride the amazing Lewis Pass – a fabulous scenic ride all the way to Punakaiki on the wild and rocky west coast. Here we visit the amazing Pancake Rocks and blow holes.

The pancake rocks began forming 30 million years ago when limestone was overlaid with softer mudstone in a succession of layers. Over years, the elements have eroded the rock, leaving a pancake effect. When the sea is rough, the sound of the blowholes can be heard for miles.



Day Three - Punakaiki to Franz Joseph Glacier 250Km. 4.5hrs in saddle

We ride the West Coast with views across the Tasman Sea. We approach Glacier Country - the roads are twisting and demanding here, slow going, but magic riding. Nowhere else in the world at this latitude have glaciers advanced so close to the coast. These majestic, awe inspiring spectacles are amazing seen from the ground, and even more stunning seen from above. A helicopter trip can take you around Mount Cook and land on the glacier - a trip you'll never forget.



Day Four - Franz Joseph to Queenstown Distance 352 kms. In saddle 5 hours

Reputably 'The best motorcycling in the world' is our next experience on the West Coast Road, designed by the grandfather of famous motorcycle designer John Britten. The famous Haast Pass 'motorcycle heaven' is on our tour agenda today. We ride through river plains, alongside clear blue lakes and the Southern Alps, on our way to Queenstown - 'adventure playground of the world'. We ride along the shore of Lake Wanaka then across the Crown Range with its awe inspiring views and tight hairpins. Just when you think there can't be any more spectacular scenery – there it is! Queenstown nestles above Lake Wakatipu with stunning views across the lake to The Remarkables We'll give you plenty of time in Queenstown to experience this fantastic spot.

Day Five - Explore Queenstown

Take a ride to nearby Arrowtown, a beautiful unspoilt turn of the century town, have a wonderful lunch at the Gibson Valley winery near the AJ Hackett Bungee Bridge Jump. White water raft or jet boat along the Shotover River. Horse trekking over the Remarkables – we can book all these adventures for you!



Day Six - Queenstown to Te Anau 170kms. In saddle 2.5 hours

Our tour takes us around the crystal waters of Lake Wakatipu to Fiordland.

Fiordland is a million hectares of remote, primeval beauty and one of the few places on the planet of untouched wilderness. Waterfalls tumble hundreds of metres into pristine forested valleys. The mirror surfaces of the fiords reflect majestic, towering mountains. Dolphins, seals and Fiordland penguins make their home here. This is where the word 'silence' takes on a new meaning. A wonderful cruise on Milford Sound is included. You can also take a boat trip across Lake Te Anau to the stunning Glow Worm caves.

Day Seven - Te Anau to Milford sound and return to Te Anau 120km each way. In saddle 4 hours. Cruise is 2.5 hour



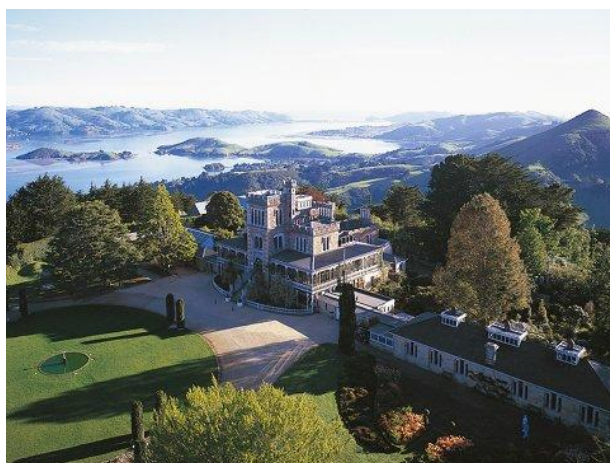
Day Eight - Te Anau to Dunedin Distance 390km In saddle 4.5 hours

Today's route is a curvaceous and undulating ride that takes us to central Otago, on our way to the very Scottish New Zealand city of Dunedin where Victorian architecture and the lovely Otago Peninsula makes this a very attractive place to visit.



Day Nine - Dunedin

Explore Dunedin City and the Otago Peninsula. We can see rare royal albatross and yellow eyed penguins in their natural habitat, winding roads with beautiful coastal views.



Day Ten - Dunedin to Tekapo 420km In the saddle 6 hours

We leave Dunedin on The 'High Road' - it's a great ride over the Maungatua Ranges. The area is characteristic of the dry Maniototo region - sparse tussock clad rolling hills. The roads are made up of sweeping bends and long straights .

Ranfurlly is an Art Deco town with some unusual architecture. The architecture came in response to a number of suspicious fires in the '30's - one builder constructed all the buildings in the Art Deco style long after its popularity had waned elsewhere.

We'll stop at Cromwell - the 'fruit bowl of New Zealand' where most of our soft fruit is grown. This town was relocated when the old Cromwell was flooded to raise the level of lake Dunster and make a hydroelectric power station

Our next adventure is riding the famous Lindis Pass, the saddle between Lindis Valley and the Ahuriri River - a curvaceous, undulating ride through the rolling hills to central Otago. Stunningly carpeted in golden tussock, you will see many native falcons. We'll be riding in the foothills of the Alps, passing huge lakes along our way. The scenery is stunning and your camera will be working overtime!



Day Eleven - Tekapo to Christchurch 251kms In Saddle 4 hours

Lake Tekapo is the largest of the three McKenzie basin lakes with fantastic views of the tallest mountain in New Zealand, Mount Cook. The lake's turquoise colour is due to the minute particles of ground rock suspended in the glacial water. We linger at the Church of the Lonely Sheppard to admire the scenery.

We ride on to Christchurch via Burkes Pass and the lush green Canterbury plains to Christchurch. We arrive early in Christchurch, the most English New Zealand city, built around the picturesque Avon River and renowned for its wonderful gardens. Here we sadly say our good byes.

With all the usual RT equipment, PLUS Electronic Suspension Adjustment (ESA2) - change the bike suspension on the move from Comfort, Normal or Sport, one or two people, Automatic Stability Control (ASC) compares the speed of the front and rear wheels and if it detects a disparity, it controls the speed of the rear wheel to prevent a slide. Each rider must have a full, valid driving license in their own name from their country of residence or an international driving permit, with a motorcycling endorsement appropriate to the capacity of the motorcycle rented.

We recommend that you bring your own motorcycling clothing and helmet. The wearing of helmets is compulsory in New Zealand.

Our Motorcycles

All our motorcycles are latest models and are regularly maintained by fully qualified motor cycle technicians. All motorbikes have a current Registration and Certificate of Fitness.

Paradise Motorcycles NZ Ltd is licensed as a transport service and authorized to operate a rental service. We are governed by the New Zealand Land Transport Safety Authority.

Deposits and final payments

A deposit of 10% of the tour fee or 20% of the rental fee is required to secure a booking. We will send you a booking confirmation upon the payment of your deposit and give you details of how to make your final payment.

Final payment of the remainder of the tour fee and any charges for additional activities are due 90 days prior to the start date of your tour. Upon final payment, we will send you a detailed itinerary and description of your tour.

In this unlikely event, we will refund your monies in full or offer you a guided tour on another date or arrange, with your consent, an independent tour, and we will refund the difference in cost.

Driving in New Zealand

Driving is on the left hand side of the road in New Zealand. If you drive on the right in your country of residence, it is in your interest to practice right hand U turns prior to your arrival. The rider is responsible for all traffic fines and such fines can be deducted from your security bond to pay New Zealand Police. Please study the New Zealand Driving code which is available on line at www.landtransport.govt.nz/roadcode

Damage and Default

Paradise Motorcycle Tours NZ Ltd reserves the right to terminate the tour and take possession of the rental motorcycle of any person who in our opinion is likely to endanger themselves or others or if the hirer fails to comply with any of the terms of the agreement, or if the motorcycle is damaged. Replacement of a damaged motorcycle is at the discretion of Paradise Motorcycle Tours

Repairs

If you are an independent tourer and your motorcycle suffers a puncture, a repair kit is supplied with the bike and instructions are included. Please make the repair and continue with caution to the next town where the tyre should be checked and repairs carried out as necessary.

If the motor cycle requires repair, please call us on 0274 765 035. If the cost is under \$200, please go ahead and keep the receipt to show us on your return.

Our bikes are meticulously maintained, so we do not expect breakdowns. In the unlikely event of a breakdown, we have AA road side breakdown cover. If the motorcycle has a mechanical fault and is not rideable and it is not your fault, we will do our utmost to get another bike to you so you can continue your tour

Passports and Visas

You are responsible for ensuring that you have the required passport and visa to enter New Zealand. Details can be found on line at www.immigration.govt.nz/migrant/stream/visit

Mobile Phone

We provide a mobile phone with each bike. Non emergency calls will be billed to the guest at the end of the tour

Taxes

A Government Service Tax of 12.5% is included in all charges.

Return of Motorcycles

Paradise Motorcycle Tours Ltd will charge \$1000 per day for any unreturned motorcycle at the time agreed in writing on the hire agreement form, until the motorcycle is returned to our premises undamaged. This will be deducted from the security bond deposit. Leeway will be at our discretion.

Responsibility and Liability

Paradise motorcycle Tours Ltd is responsible for providing the services listed in the tour descriptions. We are not responsible for any Acts of God, strikes, weather or other events beyond our control.

Paradise motorcycle Tours Ltd and its employees do not assume responsibility or liability for injury, illness or death to a person or delay, loss or damage to property during their stay in connection with or relating to the supply or omission of air, sea and land transportation services or of accommodation, meals, facilities, entertainment or other services provided by Paradise Motorcycle Tours NZ Ltd. You, the hirer, agree to release or indemnify Paradise Motorcycle Tours Ltd, its owners and its employees against any liability we incur to anyone else resulting from your failure to follow our instructions. This exclusion is subject to any rights or remedies you may have under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993.

We reserve the right to modify any part of our tours in order to provide a consistent and smooth service.

If, for reasons beyond our control, we cannot provide the model of motorcycle booked, then we reserve the right to substitute a comparable or superior motorcycle. If a comparable or superior motorcycle cannot be provided, a pro rated refund for the difference will be paid. This will not constitute a breach of contract and does not entitle the client to any additional refund.

Travel Insurance

We strongly advise you to take out appropriate travel insurance at the time of booking. Please ensure that as well as the usual cover, the insurers are aware of, and include the fact that you will be riding a motorcycle and the motorcycles capacity. Failure to do so could result in a claim being denied for medical repatriation and its associated costs or any loss or damage to yourself and your property. It should also to cover you for loss of deposit in the event of your having to cancel your tour.

Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC)

The ACC covers New Zealand residents and visitors for medical expenses in the public system following an accident. ACC is not a replacement for travel insurance. It only covers injuries, not illnesses, and only while the person remains in New Zealand. It doesn't cover things like disrupted travel plans and lost deposits, assisted or emergency travel home or travel for family.

Motorcycle Insurance

You, the hirer, will be asked to declare that you are 25 years of age or over and have not been convicted in a criminal court for any criminal offence or for driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol. The hirer will be asked to complete an 'Agreement to Hire' form prior to starting their tour.

Our motorcycles have comprehensive insurance. a security bond of \$2,500.00 is taken on the signing of the rental agreement by way of a signed credit card voucher which is authorised but unprocessed pending the return of the bike undamaged. If the motorcycle, accessories or any third party property has suffered damage or loss we will make an assessment of the monetary value of such damage or loss and, under advice to you, will deduct this value from the security bond held.

Insurance cover is voided and the hirer is fully liable for all costs if:

1. Any of the terms of the rental agreement are breached
2. Damage to property is caused by careless, wilful or reckless driving including whilst the rider is under the influence of alcohol or drugs
3. Damage to property is caused by submersion in water, such as river crossing, including salt water, resulting from rider negligence
4. Damage to property is caused by riding on unsealed roads, beaches or cross country

5. The rider's license is invalid, not current or not appropriately rated for the motorcycle
6. The motorcycle was not locked overnight
7. The motorcycle was being ridden in an unlawful manner, such as on the right-hand side of the road
